

1 Area document, dated September 26, 1990, which is attached to Ordinance # 265, makes up
2 the Lincoln County Ambulance Service Area Plan.

3 **SECTION 2.**

4 LCC 7.810 is amended to read:

5 7.810 Definitions for LCC 7.805 to 7.855

6 The words and phrases in LCC 7.805 to 7.855 shall have the meaning provided in ORS
7 chapter [823] 682 and OAR chapter 333, division [28] 260, unless specifically defined herein
8 to have a different meaning.

9 **SECTION 3.**

10 LCC 7.820 is amended to read:

11 7.820 Ambulance Service Areas

12 *[For the efficient and effective provision of ambulance services, in accordance with the*
13 *Lincoln County Ambulance Service Plan, the ambulance service areas shown on the map*
14 *labeled as Exhibit "B" attached to Ordinance #265 are hereby adopted as the Ambulance*
15 *Service Areas and providers for Lincoln County. The Board of Commissioners, by the*
16 *adoption of an order, may adjust the boundaries of the Ambulance Service Areas from time to*
17 *time as necessary to provide efficient and effective ambulance services.]*

18 **The following are the Ambulance Service Areas for Lincoln County:**

19 **(1) ASA 1 (North Lincoln County): Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lincoln**
20 **County as described in ORS 201.210; thence East along the North boundary of Lincoln**
21 **County to the Northeast corner of Lincoln County; thence South along the boundary line**

1 between Lincoln County and Polk County to the Northeast corner of Section 24,
2 Township 8 South, Range 9 West, Willamette Meridian; thence West along section lines
3 to the Northwest corner of Section 23 Township 8 South, Range 9 West, Willamette
4 Meridian; thence South to the Southwest corner of said Section 23; thence West along
5 section lines to the Southwest corner of Section 23, Township 8 South, Range 11 West,
6 Willamette Meridian; thence North to the Northwest corner of Section 14, Township 8
7 South, Range 11 West, Willamette Meridian; thence West along the section line between
8 Sections 10 and 15, Township 8 South, Range 11 West, Willamette Meridian to the
9 Eastern boundary of the Salishan Hills subdivision; thence Northerly along the
10 boundary of Salishan Hills Subdivision to the Southwest right-of-way line of the Oregon
11 Coast Highway (State Highway 101); thence Northwesterly across said right-of-way to
12 the Siletz Bay; thence Northerly and Westerly along the center of the Siletz Bay to the
13 Pacific Ocean; thence Northerly along the Pacific Ocean to the point of beginning.

14 (2) ASA 2 (Depoe Bay Area): Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 22,
15 Township 8 South, Range 11 West, Willamette Meridian; thence Southerly along section
16 lines to the Northeast corner of Section 4, Township 10 South, Range 11 West,
17 Willamette Meridian; thence West along section lines to the Pacific Ocean; thence North
18 along the Pacific Ocean to the boundary of ASA 1 described in subsection (1) of this
19 section; thence Westerly and Southerly along the boundary of said ASA 1 to the
20 Southwest corner of Section 23, Township 8 South, Range 11 West, Willamette
21 Meridian; thence West along section lines to the point of beginning.

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NOTE: Matter in boldfaced type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing ordinance to be omitted. New sections are in boldfaced type.

1 **(3) ASA 3 (Central Lincoln County):** The remainder of Lincoln County that does
2 not lie within any other ASA.

3 **(4) ASA 4 (Waldport Area):** Beginning at the intersection of Big Creek and the
4 Oregon Coast Highway (State Highway 101); thence due West to the section line between
5 Section 1, Township 14 South, Range 12 West, Willamette Meridian, and Section 6,
6 Township 14 South, Range 11 West, Willamette Meridian; thence South along said
7 section line to the Northwest corner of Section 7, Township 14 South, Range 11 West,
8 Willamette Meridian; thence East along the North line of said Section 7 to the Northeast
9 corner of said Section 7; thence South along the East line of said Section 7 to the
10 Southeast corner of said Section 7; thence East along section lines to the Northeast corner
11 of Section 13, Township 14 South, Range 11 West, Willamette Meridian; thence South
12 along the East line of said Section 13 to the Northwest corner of Section 19, Township 14
13 South, Range 10 West, Willamette Meridian; thence East along section lines to the
14 Southeast corner of Section 18, Township 14 South, Range 9 West, Willamette Meridian,
15 which point lies on the boundary between Lincoln County and Benton County; thence
16 Westerly and Northerly along the boundary line of Lincoln County and Benton County
17 to the Northwest corner of Section 24, Township 13 South, Range 9 West, Willamette
18 Meridian; thence West along section lines to the Southwest corner of Section 18,
19 Township 13 South, Range 9 West, Willamette Meridian; thence North along section
20 lines to the Northwest corner of Section 1, Township 13 South, Range 10 West,
21 Willamette Meridian; thence West along the North line of said Section 1 to the Southeast

1 corner of Section 36, Township 12 South, Range 10 West, Willamette Meridian; thence
2 North along section lines to the Northeast corner of Section 25, Township 12 South,
3 Range 10 West, Willamette Meridian; thence West along section lines to the Northwest
4 corner of Section 30, Township 12 South, Range 10 West, Willamette Meridian; thence
5 South along the West line of said Section 30 to the Southeast corner of Section 25,
6 Township 12 South, Range 11 West, Willamette Meridian; thence West along section
7 lines to the center of the section line between Sections 28 and 33, Township 12 South,
8 Range 11 West, Willamette Meridian; thence North along the center section line of said
9 Section 28 to the center of the section line between said Section 28 and Section 21,
10 Township 12 South, Range 11 West, Willamette Meridian; thence West along the South
11 line of said Section 21 to the Southwest corner of said Section 21; thence North along the
12 West line of said Section 21 to the center of the section line between said Section 21 and
13 Section 20, Township 12 South, Range 11 West, Willamette Meridian; thence West along
14 the center section line of said Section 20 to the center of the section line between said
15 Section 20 and Section 19, Township 12 South, Range 11 West, Willamette Meridian;
16 thence North along said section line to its intersection with Beaver Creek; thence
17 Westerly and Northerly along Beaver Creek to the Pacific Ocean; thence South along the
18 Pacific Ocean to Big Creek; thence East along Big Creek to the point of beginning.

19 (5) **ASA 5 (Yachats Area): All of Lincoln County lying to the South of ASA 4 as**
20 **described in subsection (4) of this section.**

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1 **SECTION 4.**

2 LCC 7.825 is amended to read:

3 7.825 Assignment of Ambulance Service Areas

4 (1) Effective June 1, 1988, no person shall provide ambulance services in Lincoln
5 County unless an Ambulance Service Area has been assigned to that person pursuant to this
6 section.

7 (2) Any person desiring to provide ambulance services within Lincoln County shall
8 submit a letter of request, listing qualifications, to the Emergency Services Coordinator. The
9 letter of request shall be reviewed by the Lincoln County Emergency Medical Services
10 Advisory Committee, which shall recommend the assignment of Ambulance Service Areas to
11 the Board of Commissioners. The assignment of Ambulance Service Areas shall be made by
12 an order of the Board of Commissioners. In accordance with ORS chapter [823] **682** and
13 OAR chapter 333, division [28] **260**, only one ambulance service provider shall serve each
14 ambulance service area established under this plan. Letters of request allowed under this
15 subsection shall be allowed for ambulance service areas for which service has been
16 discontinued under subsection (8) of this section, or for which service area assignment has
17 been revoked under LCC 7.832, or upon renewal of the initial ambulance service areas in June
18 of 1996, in accordance with subsection (6) and (7) of this section.

19 (3) A letter of request required by subsection (2) of this section shall include the
20 following information:

1 (a) The name and address of the person applying for the assignment of an Ambulance
2 Service Area.

3 (b) The Ambulance Service Area the person desires to service and the location from
4 which ambulance services will be provided.

5 (c) A list of personnel to be used in providing ambulance service and their current
6 Emergency Medical Technician certificate number.

7 (d) A list of vehicles to be used in providing ambulance services, including year, make
8 and model, and verification that each vehicle is certified as a basic life support or advance life
9 support vehicle by the State of Oregon.

10 (e) Sufficient additional information to allow for the review of the application in light
11 of the review criteria established by the Lincoln County Ambulance Service Area Plan.

12 (f) Such additional information deemed necessary by the Lincoln County Emergency
13 Medical Services Advisory Committee or the
14 Board of Commissioners.

15 (4) Each letter of request shall be reviewed for the applicant's conformity with the
16 requirements of Oregon law for providing ambulance services, the specific criteria of the
17 Lincoln County Ambulance Services within Lincoln County.

18 (5) Persons who meet the requirements of LCC 7.805 to 7.855 and of the Ambulance
19 Service Area Plan and who were providing service on the effective date of LCC 7.805 to 7.855
20 shall be authorized to provide ambulance service for the Ambulance Service Area they were

1 serving on the effective date and may continue to provide such service during the initial
 2 ambulance service area assignment period.

3 (6) The assignment of the initial Ambulance Service Areas shall be valid from the date
 4 of issuance until June 30, 1996. Thereafter, the assignment of Ambulance Service Areas may
 5 be renewed for additional five year terms commencing on the first day of July pursuant to
 6 subsection (7) of this section and subject to the provisions for suspension or revocation as set
 7 forth in subsection (9) of this section.

8 (7) Not less than 45 days prior to the expiration of the assignment of an Ambulance
 9 Service Area, such as May 15, 1991, for the initial assignment, any person desiring the renewal
 10 of an assignment or a new assignment of an Ambulance Service Area shall submit a letter
 11 requesting to be assigned an Ambulance Service Area. The letter shall include the information
 12 required by subsection (3) of this section, except that letters of request for renewal need only
 13 provide such information necessary to bring the original letter up to date. The review of the
 14 request and assignment of the Ambulance Service Area shall be in accordance with this
 15 section.

16 (8) In the event that a person assigned an Ambulance Service Area discontinues service
 17 before the expiration of the assignment, the Board of Commissioners shall set a time by which
 18 applications must be submitted for reassignment of the Ambulance Service Area. The review
 19 of the application and assignment of the Ambulance Service Area shall be in accordance with
 20 this section, and the assignment shall be for the remainder of the term unless otherwise
 21 specified by the Board of Commissioners.

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1 (9) Not less than 15 days prior to any date when the applications for the assignment of
2 an Ambulance Service Area are due, notice of such application due date shall be posted in
3 three public places and published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in Lincoln
4 County.

5 **SECTION 5.**

6 LCC 7.840 is amended to read:

7 7.840 Emergency Medical Services Advisory Committee

8 (1) There is hereby created a Lincoln County Emergency Medical Services Advisory
9 Committee, the members of which shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioners for two-
10 year terms. The Committee shall choose its own chairperson and meet quarterly or when
11 called upon by the Board of Commissioners or its chairperson. Motions shall be passed by a
12 majority of those attending.

13 (2) The committee shall consist of:

14 (a) Five ambulance operators' representatives who are Emergency Medical
15 Technicians.

16 (b) One fire department representative.

17 (c) One emergency physician.

18 (d) One hospital administrator.

19 (e) Two public members.

20 (f) One representative of the Lincoln County Health Department.

21 (g) One representative of each 9-1-1 PSAP.

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- 1 (h) The physician advisors for each ambulance service provider.
- 2 (i) One representative of the Lincoln County Emergency Services Department.
- 3 (3) The Committee shall have the following powers and duties:
- 4 (a) Review and make recommendations to the Board of Commissioners regarding all
- 5 applications for assignment of Ambulance Service Areas.
- 6 (b) Provide for ongoing input to the county from pre-hospital care consumers,
- 7 providers, and the medical community.
- 8 (c) Periodically review the performance of ambulance service providers within Lincoln
- 9 County.
- 10 (d) Periodically review the Lincoln County Ambulance Service Area Plan and make
- 11 recommendations to the Board of Commissioners including, but not limited to:
- 12 (A) Review standards established in the plan and make recommendations regarding
- 13 improvement or new standards as required by OAR [*333-28-120(1) to (3)*] **333-260-0050**;
- 14 (B) Monitor coordination between emergency medical service resources;
- 15 (C) Review dispatch procedures and compliance; and
- 16 (D) Review the effectiveness and efficiency of the Ambulance Service Area
- 17 boundaries.
- 18 (e) Develop and implement a quality assurance program, including but not limited to
- 19 training, to ensure compliance with the Lincoln County Ambulance Service Area Plan.

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SECTION 6.

LCC 7.855 is amended to read:

7.855 Nuisance


In addition to penalties provided by LCC 7.850, violation of any of the provisions is declared to be a nuisance and may be regarded as such in all actions, suits, and proceedings unless the provisions are declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction. Pursuant to ORS [823.180(5)] **682.205(7)**, these provisions shall be enforceable by the Health Division of the State of Oregon, Department of Human Resources, in a proceeding in Circuit Court for equitable relief.

SECTION 7.


This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.




