

1 (2) The Director of the Public Works Department is delegated administrative
2 authority to restrict or limit the use of any parking area or parking space on any county
3 owned property or public property subject to county jurisdiction and control by
4 indicating the restriction or limitation on a sign conspicuously posted at that location.
5 This section does not apply to the any of the following:

6 (a) Public roads, which are subject to parking regulations and restrictions under
7 LCC 6.420.

8 (b) Parking at the Lincoln County Courthouse, which is subject to parking
9 regulations and restrictions under LCC 7.605 to 7.625.

10 (c) Parking at county parks, which are subject to parking regulations and
11 restrictions under LCC 9.020 and 9.025.

12 (3) A parking restriction or limitation imposed by the Director under this section
13 may be:

14 (a) A total prohibition on parking within the designated area;

15 (b) A limitation on parking within the designated area during specified times of
16 the day or night or day of week;

17 (c) A limitation on the length of time that a vehicle may be parked in the
18 designated area;

19 (d) A limitation on the type of vehicle that may be parked in the designated area;

20 or

1 (e) Any combination of one or more of the limitations described in paragraphs (a)
2 though (d) of this subsection.

3 (4) A parking restriction or limitation imposed by the Director under this section
4 is not effective until the appropriate sign indicating the restriction or limitation is posted
5 at the designated area.

6 **SECTION 4.**

7 **7.660 Prohibition of Parking in Violation of Restriction or Limitation;**
8 **Enforcement**

9 (1) No person shall park in a parking area or parking space in violation of a
10 parking restriction or limitation imposed under LCC 7.655.

11 (2) Enforcement of this section may be carried out by one or more of the following
12 methods:

13 (a) Citation:

14 A vehicle parked in violation of this section is subject to being cited for a parking
15 violation in accordance with the Oregon Vehicle Code, LCC chapter 10, or both.

16 (b) Impoundment:

17 A vehicle parked in violation of this section is subject to being impounded in
18 accordance with the procedures provided in ORS 809.725 and 819.180.

19 (c) Nuisance Abatement:

20 A nuisance abatement action in accordance with LCC chapter 10 may be filed
21 against any person who repeatedly parks in violation of this section.



SECTION 5.


This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,






