8                   The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

9                   **SECTION 1.**

10                  Section 2 of this Ordinance is added to and made a part of LCC Chapter 7, as indicated.

11                  **SECTION 2.**

12                  **7.828 Additional Requirement for Applicants for Assignment of ASA 1 or 3**

13                  **In addition to the requirements and provisions of LCC 7.827:**

14                  **(1) Each applicant for assignment of ASA 1 or 3, or both ASA 1 and 3, must also**  
15 **apply for assignment of ASA 2, and the failure to do so by an applicant shall invalidate**  
16 **their application.**

17                  **(2) The Board of Commissioners may assign ASA 2 to an applicant assigned**  
18 **ASA 1, an applicant assigned ASA 3, an applicant assigned ASA 1 and 3, or another**  
19 **applicant.**


1           **(3) If an ambulance service provider assigned to provide ambulance service to**  
2           **ASA 2 rejects, abandons, or otherwise ceases to provide ambulance service to ASA 2,**  
3           **that cessation of service shall be deemed an abandonment of all other ambulance**  
4           **service areas assigned to that provider in Lincoln County.**

5           **SECTION 3.**


6           This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,


