6 **Relating to forfeited property; creating new provisions; and declaring an emergency.**

8 The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 Sections 2 and 3 of this Ordinance are added to and made apart of LCC Chapter 2, as
11 indicated.

12 **SECTION 2.**

13 **2.3010 Disposition of Certain Forfeiture Proceeds Subject to Section 25(2),**
14 **Chapter 780, 2001 Oregon Laws**

15 **(1) After required distributions pursuant to ORS Chapter 475A, net forfeiture**
16 **proceeds that are subject to Section 25(2), Chapter 780, 2001 Oregon Laws, and**
17 **derived from civil forfeitures resulting from seizures by the Lincoln Interagency**
18 **Narcotics Team or derived from the sale of vehicles forfeited pursuant to LCC 2.3000,**
19 **may be disbursed by forfeiture counsel for any or all of the following purposes:**

20 **(a) Drug treatment.**

21 **(b) Alcohol treatment.**

22 **(c) Mental health treatment.**

1 **(d) Drug education.**

2 **(e) Alcohol education.**

3 **(f) Mental health education.**

4 **(2) Forfeiture counsel shall have authority to enter into intergovernmental and**
5 **interagency agreements providing for distributions under subsection (1) of this section.**

6 **SECTION 3.**

7 **2.3015 Disposition of Certain Vehicles Forfeited Under LCC 2.3000**

8 **(1) Notwithstanding the disposition of vehicles as provided in LCC 7.020(19),**
9 **vehicles forfeited pursuant to LCC 2.3000 which forfeiture counsel determines are not**
10 **fit or desirable to make available for sale, may be donated by forfeiture counsel to the**
11 **Lincoln County Fair and Rodeo for crushing in motor sport events conducted at the**
12 **Lincoln County Fairgrounds.**

13 **(2) Forfeiture counsel may also trade or exchange vehicles described in**
14 **subsection (1) of this section for other vehicles that are more suitable or desirable for**
15 **motor sport crushing. All trades and exchanges under this subsection shall be with a**
16 **vehicle dealer, wrecker, or towing business licensed under ORS Chapter 822.**

17 **(3) Forfeiture counsel may display, paint, mark, or otherwise designate vehicles**
18 **to be disposed of under this section as having been forfeited under LCC 2.3000.**

19 **(4) Forfeiture counsel shall have authority to enter into agreements providing**
20 **for disposition of vehicles under this section.**




