6 **Relating to special road districts; creating new provisions; and declaring an emergency.**

8                   The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

9                   **SECTION 1.**

10                   Section 2 of this Ordinance is added to and made apart of LCC Chapter 6, as  
11 indicated.

12                   **SECTION 2.**

13                   **6.480 Election of Board Members of California Street Special Road District**

14                   **(1) In accordance with ORS 371.318(2), the Lincoln County Board of**  
15 **Commissioners hereby changes the method of selecting the board members of the**  
16 **California Street Special Road District. The method of selecting board members for**  
17 **the California Street Special Road District shall be by election.**

18                   **(2) In accordance with ORS 371.349(1), the board of the California Street**  
19 **Special Road district shall consist of three members elected by the electors of the**  
20 **district, and the term of office for a board member shall be four years commencing on**  
21 **July 1 following the date of election.**

1 (3) ORS chapter 255 governs the nomination and election of the board members  
2 and the conduct of the elections.

3 (4) The first elected board of the California Street Special Road District shall be  
4 elected on the third Tuesday in May of 2003. In accordance with ORS 371.349(2) and  
5 notwithstanding the four-year term of office described in subsection (2) of this section,  
6 for the first board elected, the term of one board member shall end on June 30, 2005,  
7 as designated by the County Clerk.


8 (5) In accordance with ORS 371.318(3), the County shall pay the costs of  
9 conducting the elections at which the board members are elected.


10 **SECTION 3.**


11 This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,


