6 **Relating to special road districts; amending LCC 6.480; and declaring an emergency.**

8 WHEREAS, after further public input, the Board has determined that it needs to
9 modify Ordinance # 423; therefore,

10 The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

11 **SECTION 1.**

12 LCC 6.480 is amended to read:

13 6.480 Election of Board Members of [*California Street*] **Certain** Special Road
14 [*District*] **Districts**

15 (1) In accordance with ORS 371.318(2), the Lincoln County Board of
16 Commissioners hereby changes the method of selecting the board members of [*all special*
17 *road districts in Lincoln County*] **the following special road districts:**

18 **(a) California Street Special Road District.**

19 **(b) Panther Creek Special Road District.**

20 **(c) Little Switzerland Special Road District.**

21 (2) The method of selecting board members for [*all special road districts in Lincoln*
22 *County*] **the road districts identified in subsection (1) of this section shall be by election.**

1 ~~[(2)]~~ (3) In accordance with ORS 371.349(1), the board of *[each special road district*
2 *in Lincoln County]* **each district identified in subsection (1) of this section** shall consist of
3 three members elected by the electors of *[the]* **each respective** district, and the term of
4 office for a board member shall be four years commencing on July 1 following the date of
5 election.

6 ~~[(3)]~~ (4) ORS chapter 255 governs the nomination and election of the board
7 members and the conduct of the elections.

8 ~~[(4)]~~ (5) The first elected board of each special road district *[in Lincoln County]*
9 **identified in subsection (1) of this section** shall be elected on the third Tuesday in May of
10 2003. In accordance with ORS 371.349(2) and notwithstanding the four-year term of office
11 described in subsection (2) of this section, for each first board elected, the term of one board
12 member shall end on June 30, 2005, as designated by the County Clerk.

13 ~~[(5)]~~ (6) In accordance with ORS 371.318(3), the County shall pay the costs of
14 conducting the elections at which the board members are elected.
