6 **Relating to special road districts; amending LCC 6.480; and declaring an emergency.**

8 WHEREAS the Board has received a request to convert Coronado Shores Special
9 Road District from having appointed directors to having elected directors; and

10 WHEREAS the Board has agreed to make that conversion; therefore,

11 The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

12 **SECTION 1.**

13 LCC 6.480 is amended to read:

14 6.480 Election of Board Members of Certain Special Road Districts

15 (1) In accordance with ORS 371.318(2), the Lincoln County Board of
16 Commissioners hereby changes the method of selecting the board members of the following
17 special road districts:

18 (a) California Street Special Road District.

19 (b) Panther Creek Special Road District.

20 (c) Little Switzerland Special Road District.

21 **(d) Coronado Shores Special Road District.**

1 (2) The method of selecting board members for the road districts identified in
2 subsection (1) of this section shall be by election.

3 (3) In accordance with ORS 371.349(1), the board of each district identified in
4 subsection (1) of this section shall consist of three members elected by the electors of each
5 respective district, and the term of office for a board member shall be four years
6 commencing on July 1 following the date of election.

7 (4) ORS chapter 255 governs the nomination and election of the board members and
8 the conduct of the elections.

9 (5) The first elected board of each special road district identified in subsection (1)(a)
10 **through (c)** of this section shall be elected on the third Tuesday in May of 2003. In
11 accordance with ORS 371.349(2) and notwithstanding the four-year term of office described
12 in subsection *[(2)]* **(3)** of this section, for each first board elected, the term of one board
13 member shall end on June 30, 2005, as designated by the County Clerk.

14 **(6) The first elected board of the special road district identified in subsection**
15 **(1)(d) of this section shall be elected on the third Tuesday in May of 2005. In**
16 **accordance with ORS 371.349(2) and notwithstanding the four-year term of office**
17 **described in subsection (3) of this section, for each first board elected, the term of one**
18 **board member shall end on June 30, 2007, as designated by the County Clerk.**

19 *[(6)]* (7) In accordance with ORS 371.318(3), the County shall pay the costs of
20 conducting the elections at which the board members are elected.

SECTION 2.


This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
