8 The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 Section 2 of this Ordinance is added to and made a part of LCC Chapter 2, as
11 indicated.

12 **SECTION 2.**

13 **2.4100 Sustainable Energy; Wave Energy Power Project**

14 (1) The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners declares that the development of
15 sustainable energy in Lincoln County is vital to economic development and public health and
16 safety in Lincoln County, and therefore hereby specifically exercises its authority to pursue the
17 development of sustainable energy resources, including, but not limited to, wave energy
18 generation.

19 (2) In order to facilitate the development of sustainable energy resources in Lincoln
20 County, the Office of Lincoln County Legal Counsel is hereby authorized to engage in all
21 proceedings and processes necessary to facilitate that development, including, but not
22 limited to, application for any required or appropriate permits, licenses, and certificates, and


1 negotiation of any necessary or appropriate contracts, intergovernmental agreements, and
2 interconnection agreements.

3 **SECTION 3.**


4 This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,


