6 **Relating to fees; amending LCC 7.760; and declaring an emergency.**

9 The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

10 **SECTION 1.**

11 LCC 7.760 is amended to read:

12 7.760 Penalties

13 (1) As a condition of any alarm system permit issued under the provisions of LCC
14 7.705 to 7.775, the alarm user shall pay to the county, within 10 days of invoice, fees for false
15 alarms generated by the alarm user's alarm system according to the **fee schedule adopted by**
16 **the Board of Commissioners.** *[following schedule:]*

17 *[(a) First two alarms during each calendar year: No charge.]*

18 *[(b) For each false alarm thereafter: \$100 per false alarm.]*

19 *[(c)]* The alarm user's permit shall be subject to revocation in the event ten or more
20 false alarms are generated within a calendar year.

21 (2) Violation of provisions of LCC 7.705 to 7.775 and the administrative rules issued
22 pursuant to LCC 7.705 to 7.775 are punishable by revocation of the permit by the sheriff or his
23 agent, and such further remedies as are provided in LCC chapter 10, and any other pertinent
24 statutes, rules, and remedies at common law.

SECTION 2.


This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.




