5 ORDINANCE # 498

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8 **Relating to special road districts; and amending LCC 6.480; and**

9  
10 WHEREAS the Board has decided to convert Starr Creek Special Road District from  
11 having an appointed governing board to having an elected governing board, ORS Chapter 371,  
12 based on governance issues raised by District residents; and

13 WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that it is appropriate to place the election  
14 of District Board members on the May, 2018, ballot, so that the newly elected directors can begin  
15 serving their terms on July 1, 2018;

16 Now, therefore, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

17 **SECTION 1.**

18 LCC 6.480 is amended to read:

19 6.480 Election of Board Members of Certain Special Road Districts

20 (1) In accordance with ORS 371.318(2), the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners  
21 hereby changes the method of selecting the board members of the following special road districts:

22 (a) California Street Special Road District.

23 (b) Panther Creek Special Road District.

24 (c) Little Switzerland Special Road District.

25 (d) Coronado Shores Special Road District.

26 (e) Surfland Special Road District

27 **(f) Starr Creek Special Road District**

28 (2) The method of selecting board members for the road districts identified in subsection  
29 (1) of this section shall be by election.

1 (3) In accordance with ORS 371.349(1), the board of each district identified in subsection  
2 (1) of this section shall consist of three members elected by the electors of each respective district,  
3 and the term of office for a board member shall be four years commencing on July 1 following the  
4 date of election.

5 (4) ORS chapter 255 governs the nomination and election of the board members and the  
6 conduct of the elections.

7 (5) The first elected board of each special road district identified in subsection (1)(a)  
8 through (c) of this section shall be elected on the third Tuesday in May of 2003. In accordance  
9 with ORS 371.349(2) and notwithstanding the four-year term of office described in subsection (3)  
10 of this section, for each first board elected, the term of one board member shall end on June 30,  
11 2005, as designated by the County Clerk.

12 (6) The first elected board of the special road district identified in subsection (1)(d) of this  
13 section shall be elected on the third Tuesday in May of 2005. In accordance with ORS 371.349(2)  
14 and notwithstanding the four-year term of office described in subsection (3) of this section, for  
15 each first board elected, the term of one board member shall end on June 30, 2007, as designated  
16 by the County Clerk.

17 (7) The first elected board of the special road district identified in subsection (1)(e) of this  
18 section shall be elected on the third Tuesday in May 2013. In accordance with ORS 371.349(2)  
19 and notwithstanding the four year term of office described in subsection (3) of this section, for  
20 each first board elected, the term of one board member shall end on June 30, 2015, as designated  
21 by the County Clerk.

22 **(8) The first elected board of the special road district identified in subsection (1)(f) of**  
23 **this section shall be elected on the third Tuesday in May 2018. Notwithstanding the four**  
24 **year term of office described in subsection (3) of this section, for each first board elected, the**  
25 **term of one board member shall end on June 30, 2019, and the term of the other two board**  
26 **members shall end on June 30, 2021, as designated by the County Clerk.**

27 ~~[(8)]~~ **(9)** In accordance with ORS 371.318(3), the County shall pay the costs of conducting  
28 the elections at which the board members are elected.


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**SECTION 2.**


