**Relating to the Repeal of Sections 8.005 to 8.035 of the Lincoln County Code Regarding  
"Determining Community Opinions"**

Findings:

WHEREAS, Sections 8.005 to 8.035(Determining Community Opinions) of the Lincoln County Code (LCC) currently provides a procedure by which the Board may submit questions to the electorate for an advisory opinion; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners have rarely utilized the LCC Sections 8.005-8.035 procedure; and

WHEREAS, there are other more appropriate and efficient means of polling public opinion outside of the election process; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that Sections 8.005 to 8.035 be repealed;


**NOW, THEREFORE, THE LINCOLN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

SECTION 1: Repeal of Section 8.005 to 8.035 of the Lincoln County Code






